

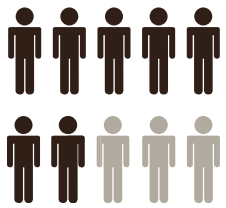

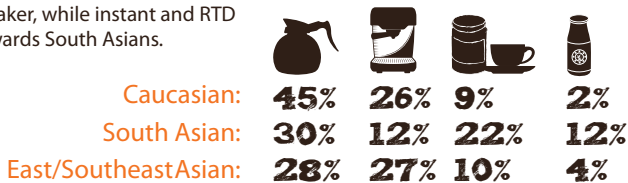
## SINGLE-CUP BREWER PENETRATION STAGNATES

Percent Canadians Aged 18-79 Who Own A Single-Cup System

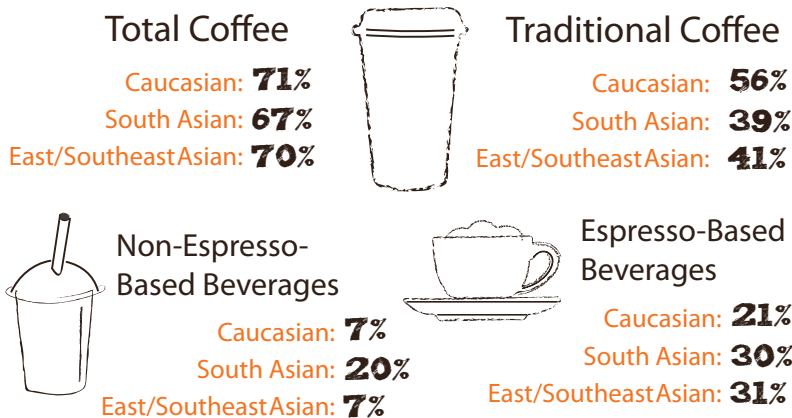


## METHOD OF PREPARATION AMONG CANADIAN PAST-DAY COFFEE DRINKERS AGED 18-79

Among past-day coffee drinkers, Caucasians are most likely to use a drip coffee maker, while instant and RTD skew towards South Asians.

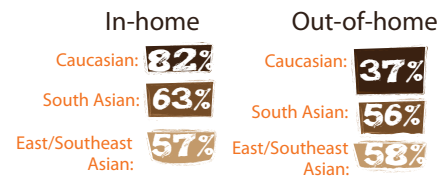


## % CANADIANS AGED 18-79 WHO DRANK COFFEE TYPES YESTERDAY



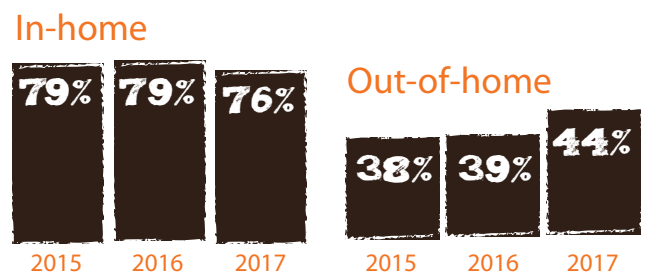
## PLACE OF PREPARATION AMONG PAST- DAY CANADIAN COFFEE DRINKERS AGED 18-79

is driven by Caucasians



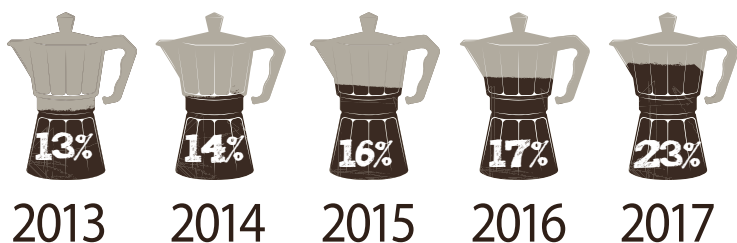
## % PLACE OF CONSUMPTION AMONG PAST-DAY CANADIAN COFFEE DRINKERS AGED 18-79

Coffee consumption shifts in favour of out-of-home

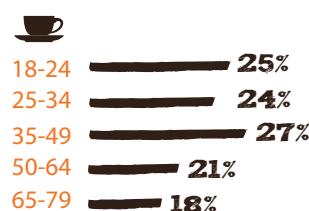

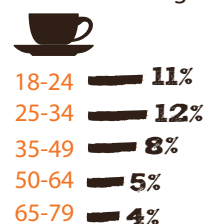
Percent Canadians Aged 18-79 Who Drank EBB Yesterday
